


Mornington Primary School

- ✓ Tell a member of staff if I am worried or unhappy
- ✓ Attend school every day and on time

- ✓ Provide a safe, fair and happy environment where all children are valued, respected and listened to
- ✓ Provide high quality teaching and an engaging curriculum to meet the needs of all children
- ✓ Provide as much support and challenge as we can to help your child meet their full potential
- ✓ Support your child to understand their role in the wider community
- ✓ Encourage high standards of behaviour
- ✓ Teach your child to develop a positive attitude to others, regardless of age, disability, gender reassignment, race, religion or belief, sex, marriage or civil partnership
- ✓ Respect the confidentiality of information regarding each child
- ✓ Listen openly to concerns from children/parents
- ✓ Communicate effectively with parents

- ✓ Send my child prepared for school in the appropriate uniform and with the appropriate equipment
- ✓ Ensure that my child arrives and is collected on time every day
- ✓ Ensure that my child attends school unless they are too poorly
- ✓ Encourage my child to be Ready, Respectful and Responsible
- ✓ Attend parents' meetings and support school activities where possible
- ✓ Be an active part of my child's education and support the school ethos
- ✓ Ensure careful and considerate parking at the school entrance
- ✓ Ensure that my child is ready for school
- ✓ Encourage my child's learning in all areas and support them with home-based tasks
- ✓ Be an active communicator – informing the school if there are issues that might affect my child's work or behavior and report any concerns
